Dear Ms. Nelson:

This office represents the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board. The Complaint Review Committee met to review the above complaint against you. The Committee found probable cause of violations of K.S.A. 65-6311(a)(4) and K.A.R. 102-2-7, practicing social work in an incompetent manner. Specifically, on or about August 1, 2013, while performing your duties as a social worker, you failed to supervise an individual with a known history of violence and drug abuse with his infant child, which resulted in serious injury to the infant.

The Board has determined the appropriate sanction on this complaint to be a Formal Censure pursuant to K.S.A. 74-7508(f). You should consider this letter to be the Formal Censure. This sanction will not affect your ability to practice social work in Kansas.


