

STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 10 day of NOVEMBER 1987, by and between the KANSAS BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES REGULATORY BOARD (Board) and Allan H. Marquardt, Ph.D. (Licensee).

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Board received a complaint about certain conduct of the Licensee in his practice of social work; and

WHEREAS, the Board conducted an informal investigatory inquiry concerning the respondent's alleged violations of K.S.A. 74-5356(a)(4), (5), as defined by K.A.R. 102-2-7(b)(13), (16), (19); and

WHEREAS, the parties mutually desire to enter into this agreement in lieu of further proceedings.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the conditions, covenants and promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Licensee will complete a self-directed learning project focusing on patient's rights.
2. The Board will provide to the Licensee the guidelines which must be met to complete the project.
3. Within two weeks of receipt of the project guidelines, the Licensee must submit to the Board office a plan by which the project will be completed.
4. The plan must meet the approval of the social work representative(s) of the Board.
5. The Licensee must complete the project within two months from the date the plan is approved.
6. The project will consist of a twenty-page paper on patient's rights and must be submitted to the Board office for final approval.

7. If the social work representative(s) find the paper unacceptable, the Licensee will be asked to rewrite the paper until it is found to be acceptable.

a. If the Licensee is required to rewrite the paper, the social work representative(s) will establish time deadlines by which the paper must be re-submitted for approval.

8. The Licensee shall be responsible for all costs of the project.

9. Upon successful completion of the project, the complaint against the licensee will be dismissed.

10. If Licensee fails to comply with the provisions of this agreement, the Board may terminate the agreement and proceed with a formal administrative hearing.

11. This stipulation constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and may be modified or amended only by written instrument signed by the parties.
