STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 26th day of July, 1989, by and between the KANSAS BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES REGULATORY BOARD (Board) and Dolores Greene (Licensee), LSCSW.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Board received a complaint about certain conduct of the Licensee in her practice of social work; and

WHEREAS, the Board conducted an informal investigatory inquiry concerning the Licensee's alleged violations of Kansas social work statutes and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the parties mutually desire to enter into this agreement in lieu of further proceedings.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the conditions, covenants and promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Licensee will complete a self-directed learning project. The project will consist of a typed paper, 25 pages in length. The paper shall discuss dual relationships, focusing on the social work relationship.
2. The Board will provide to the Licensee the guidelines which must be met to complete the project.

3. Within fourteen (14) days of receipt of the project guidelines, the Licensee must submit to the Board office a plan by which the project will be completed.

4. The plan must meet the approval of the members of the informal investigatory panel (panel members). The Board will notify the Licensee when the plan is approved.

5. The Licensee must complete the project within ninety (90) days from the date the plan is approved.

6. If the panel members find that the paper does not meet the established guidelines, the Licensee will be asked to rewrite the paper until it is found to be acceptable.

- a. If the Licensee is required to rewrite the paper, the panel member will establish time deadlines by which the paper must be re-submitted for approval.

7. The Licensee shall be responsible for all costs of the project.

8. Upon successful completion of the project, the complaint against the Licensee will be dismissed.

9. The Licensee will not receive continuing education credit, as provided in K.A.R. 1987 Supp. 102-2-4a, for this self-directed learning project.

10. If Licensee fails to comply with the provisions of this agreement, the Board may terminate the agreement and proceed with further proceedings.

11. The Licensee has ten (10) days from receipt of this agreement to agree to the stipulations contained herein by signing the same and returning the agreement to the Board's office. Failure to complete and return within ten days may result in the Board pursuing remedies available to it by law.

12. This stipulation constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and may be modified or amended only by written instrument signed by the parties.
