CONSENT AGREEMENT AND ORDER

Now on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of JUNE, 1994,  
the above-captioned matter comes before the Kansas  
Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board, by agreement of  
Terrie L. Price, Ph.D. and the Kansas Behavioral Sciences  
Regulatory Board (Board) for the purpose of settling the  
above-captioned case.

The parties hereby acknowledge the following:

1. Terrie L. Price, Ph.D., hereinafter,  
Respondent, is authorized to practice psychology within the  
State of Kansas under authority of the licensure of  
psychologists act, K.S.A. 74-5301, et seq.

2. On or about April 2, 1992, the Board  
received a report alleging violations of the statutes and  
regulations regulating the practice of psychology.

3. The Board conducted an investigation  
concerning the above-referenced allegation.

4. During the investigation, Respondent was informed of the reported information and given the opportunity to respond to the allegations.

5. The original complaint was not substantiated. However, in the course of the investigation, the board became concerned that Dr. Price failed to supervise an unlicensed assistant in the manner prescribed by K.A.R. 102-1-11(a)(1-4). If proven true, such allegation would constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5324(d) and K.A.R. 102-1-10(b)(25).

6. Respondent denies any wrongdoing.

HOWEVER, Respondent and the Board mutually desire to enter into this Consent Agreement and Order in lieu of adjudicative proceedings to resolve the report of alleged violations.

WHEREFORE, solely for the purposes of this settlement, the parties hereby consent and agree to the following terms and conditions:

A. Respondent waives all rights to an adjudication of facts and law which could be determined pursuant to a hearing conducted in accordance with the Kansas administrative procedure act in relation to Case No. 405.

B. Respondent waives the right to file a motion for reconsideration and all rights of appeal pursuant to the Kansas act for judicial review in relation to Case No. 405.

C. The parties agree and stipulate as follows:

1. At all times relevant hereto, Respondent supervised the professional services of Rodge C. Moore, M.S., an unlicensed assistant, during Respondent's tenure as a psychologist with Christian Psychological Services (CPS).

2. Respondent did not have personal contact with all of the patients seen by Mr. Moore.

3. The patients seen by Mr. Moore were sometimes diagnosed, after consultation between Mr. Moore and Respondent, without Respondent having ever seen the patients, and often without the benefit of psychological testing.

4. Mr. Moore's graduate degree is in counseling, not clinical psychology or counseling psychology.

5. Even though Mr. Moore was considered Respondent's unlicensed assistant, Mr. Moore was the director of CPS.

D. Respondent agrees to demonstrate learning and knowledge of ethical obligations and rules of conduct

pertaining to supervising unlicensed assistants by writing and submitting a written article on that topic of at least twenty (20) pages, double spaced with at least four (4) sources. Such article will be written in APA format, and is subject to review and approval by a Board member to be announced. Further, such article will be presented to the designated Board member within 120 days of accepting this consent agreement.

E. During the time this agreement is in effect, Respondent will not be approved by the Board as a supervisor over another psychologist who, as a term or condition to an order of the Board, is required to be professionally supervised.

F. This agreement is not to be construed to prohibit the Board, upon request of any person, including another state licensing board, from supplying notice or confirmation of the existence of this agreement, or from supplying a copy of this agreement to any such person.

G. The Board agrees that upon approval of the article by the designated Board member, the complaint file will be presented at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board, and such complaint will be dismissed.

H. This Consent Agreement and Order constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and may be


modified or amended only by written agreement signed by the parties.

WHEREFORE, the provisions above are hereby made the final order of the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board.


