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**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED PERMANENT REGULATIONS  
For  
CLINICAL SUPERVISOR TRAINING STANDARDS FOR MARRIAGE AND FAMILY  
THERAPISTS AND PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS**

**K.A.R. 102-3-7b and K.A.R. 102-5-7b**

The Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board will conduct a public hearing from 10:00 – 11:00 A.M. on Thursday, July 27, 2017 in the board conference room at 700 SW Harrison St. Ste-420, Topeka, Kansas to consider adopting permanent rules and regulations for clinical supervisor training standards for professional counselors and marriage and family therapists.

This 60-day notice of the public hearing constitutes a public comment period for purposes of receiving written public comments on the proposed regulations. All interested parties may submit written comments prior to the hearing to Max L. Foster, Jr., Executive Director, Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board, 700 SW Harrison St. Ste-420, Topeka, KS 66603-3929. E-mail comments may be directed to [max.foster@ks.gov](mailto:max.foster@ks.gov). All interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity to present their views orally at the hearing. In order to give all parties an opportunity to present their views, it may be necessary to request each participant to limit any oral presentation to five minutes.

Any individual with a disability may request accommodation in order to participate in the public hearing and may request the proposed regulations and economic impact statement in an accessible format. The following is a summary of the proposed regulations and economic statement. The board does not have a less costly or less intrusive method for achieving the stated purpose of these regulations.

**K.A.R. 102-3-7b** Implements the approved 2016 statute (K.S.A. 65-5818) that identifies the training requirements that must be met for an individual to receive the designation of board approved clinical supervisor associated with the licensure of Professional Counselors.

**K.A.R. 102-5-7b** Implements the approved 2016 statute (K.S.A. 65-6414) that identifies the training requirements that must be met for an individual to receive the designation of board approved clinical supervisor associated with the licensure of Marriage and Family Therapists.

**Economic impact:** There would be an economic impact to Professional Counselor and Marriage and Family Therapy Supervisors as a result of the requirement for their licensure under these regulations. There would be no economic impact to other BSRB licensees, any other governmental agencies, or the public.
