When licensees are practicing under an approved training plan, they may not count clinical staff meetings toward supervision requirements for clinical licensure.

4) Update on Missouri / Kansas AAMFT Division.

The newly formed Missouri / Kansas AAMFT Division has been approved by AAMFT. The new division has a website, elected board of directors and is planning the Spring 2019 Conference. The focus is to present workshops, trainings, and CEUs for MFTs. This new group takes the place of the Kansas AMFT which was dissolved. Jurdene Ingram sits on the new board of directors.

- 5) Mobility of licensure to MFTs to Kansas. The following items were discussed.
 - a. AAMFT Licensure Mobility Survey Committee performed a study which had a May 2018 deadline.
 - b. BSRB recognizes the challenge of all mental health professionals who desire to be licensed in Kansas when applying through reciprocity. Every state is struggling with this same issue.
 - c. Evaluate what other states' programs require for licensure.
- 6) **New Business.** The Board asked that each advisory committee discuss Temporary Licenses and Training Plans: Should a temporary license holder have a training plan (has not sat for exam)?
 - a. Temporary Licenses. Committee members were asked to email comments to either Max or Leslie.
 - b. Training Plans. Committee members were asked to email comments to either Max or Leslie.
