Kansas Fights Addiction Grant Review Board Update July 2023

The Kansas Fights Addiction Grant Review Board (KFAB) has met twice since your last update.

May 12

The KFAB Board met to review progress on the RFPs. The second focusing on prevention was released. The first RFP window has closed. There were 71 total applications received from 62 unique entities. The process for the initial scoring and review by the KFAB Board was set.

June 9

Updates on Treatment RFP. All congressional districts received multiple applications and all priority areas and strategies received at least 2 applications.

The Prevention RFP has received 67 confirmations of an intent to apply. That process closes June 23.

A conflict of interest review was presented by the AG's office. All board members will be required to acknowledge understanding of conflict of interest and disclose any conflicts they may have.
