- **102-5-15.** Services rendered to individuals located in this state. Except as authorized by K.S.A. 65-6409, and amendments thereto, each person, regardless of the person's <u>physical</u> location, who engages in either of the following activities shall be deemed to be engaged in the practice of <u>applied behavior analysis</u> in this state and shall be required to have a license, issued by the board, to practice <u>applied behavior analysis</u> as a <u>licensed behavior analyst</u> or a <u>licensed assistant behavior analyst</u>, as appropriate:
- (a) performs any act included in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 65-6402, and amendments thereto, on or for one or more individuals who are <u>physically</u> located in this state <u>at the time services are provided</u>; or
- (b) represents oneself to be a <u>licensed behavior analyst</u> or a <u>licensed assistant behavior analyst</u> available to perform any act included in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 65-6402, and amendments thereto, on or for one or more individuals who are <u>physically located</u> in this state <u>at the time services are provided</u>.
