Dear Mr. Moorehead:

This office represents the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board. The Complaint Review Committee met last week and reviewed your self-report of practicing on an expired license for fifteen days. The Board has found probable cause of violations of KSA 65-6303(a), engaging in the practice of social work without a current license, KSA 65-6311((a)(4) and KAR 102-2-7(yy) and (zz).

In light of the self-report and no history of other violations, the Committee has determined the appropriate sanction to be a formal reprimand. You should consider this letter to be a formal reprimand. This sanction does not affect your ability to continue to practice social work. You have the right to appeal this decision by requesting a formal hearing. Your request for hearing must be received in the Board office, 712 South Kansas Avenue, Topeka, KS 66603 within 15 days of the date of this letter.
