**SUMMARY PROCEEDING ORDER**

NOW on this 4<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2007, the above-captioned complaint comes before the Complaint Review Committee of the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board [Board].

**Findings of Fact**

The Committee finds that the following facts have been established by clear and convincing evidence:

1. Yolonda S. Jarman is a Licensed Master Level Psychologist Temporary, License #1007T, which was issued by the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board.
2. At all times relevant to the complaint herein, Licensee was practicing as a Licensed Master Level Psychologist Temporary within the meaning of the Kansas Licensure of Psychologists Act, K.S.A. 74-5301 *et seq.* and amendments thereto.

3. On or about February 9, 2007, the Board received a complaint that Licensee was dating the husband/father of a family for which she was providing therapeutic family preservation services. On or about February 12, 2007, the Board received a second complaint from a different person regarding this dual relationship.

4. Licensee was informed about the complaints and was requested to respond to them in writing. On July 5, 2007, the Board received a written response in which Licensee acknowledged violating professional ethics by entering an intimate relationship with a client or the immediate family of a client while providing court-ordered therapeutic services to the family. 5. Licensee offered to surrender her license but failed to do so within three months of making that offer.

### **Conclusions of Law**

The following conclusions of law are based on evidence the Board finds is clear and convincing:

1. The Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-537 provides that a state agency may use summary proceedings, subject to a party's request for a hearing on the order, if the use of the proceedings in the circumstances does not violate any provision of law and the protection of the public interest does not require the state agency to give notice and an opportunity to participate to persons other than the parties.

2. The actions of Licensee Yolonda S. Jarman violate K.S.A. 74-5324 (d) unprofessional conduct, as defined in K.A.R. 102-4-12(b)(2)(c), (b)25 and (b)(26).

**Sanction**

Based on the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Complaint Review Committee finds pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5301, *et seq.*, and K.S.A. 77-537 that the Kansas Master Level Psychologist Temporary license of Licensee Yolonda S. Jarman should be suspended indefinitely until further order of this Committee.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
