CONSENT AGREEMENT AND ORDER

NOW, on this 29 day of May, 2014, the above-captioned matter comes before the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board (Board), by and through Assistant Attorney General Whitney L. Casement, by agreement of Ann D. Goodall (Licensee) and the Board for the purpose of resolving the above-captioned case.

Licensee hereby acknowledges the following:

1. Ann D. Goodall is a Licensed Bachelor Social Worker, License #5220, which was issued by the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board.
2. At all times relevant to the complaint herein, Licensee was practicing as a Licensed Bachelor Social Worker (LBSW) within the meaning of the Kansas Social Workers Licensure Act, K.S.A. 65-6301, *et seq.*, and amendments thereto.
3. On or about February 13, 2012, the Board received a self-report of information concerning Licensee's conduct, alleging Licensee may have violated certain statutes and regulations governing her license as a Licensed Bachelor Social Worker.
4. The Board conducted an investigation concerning Licensee's alleged violation of statutes and regulations:

5. As a result of the investigation, the Board finds that the following facts have been established by a preponderance of clear and convincing evidence:

- a. Licensee's LBSW license expired on December 31, 2011.
- b. On January 30, 2012, Licensee discovered that her Kansas license had expired.
- c. Licensee continued to practice social work during the time her license was expired from January 1, 2012 through February 9, 2012.
- d. Licensee self-reported to the Board on February 13, 2012.
- e. Licensee failed to notify her employer, Kansas Social Rehabilitation Services, that her license had expired until after March 22, 2012. Licensee continued to perform her assigned work duties during the time her license was expired.
- f. Licensee's LBSW license was reinstated on February 10, 2012.

6. The Complaint Review Committee of the Board finds that Licensee has violated the following statute and regulations:

A. K.S.A. 65-6311. Grounds for suspension, limitation, revocation or refusal to issue or renew license; procedure.

(a) The board may suspend, limit, revoke, condition or refuse to issue or renew a license of any social worker upon proof that the social worker:

...

(4) has been found guilty of unprofessional conduct as defined by rules established by the board.

B. K.A.R. 102-2-7. Unprofessional conduct.

Any of the following acts by a licensee or applicant for a social work license shall constitute unprofessional conduct:

...

(w) engaging in professional activities, including billing practices and advertising, involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit, or misrepresentation;

(yy) practicing social work after one's license expires;

(zz) using without a license, or continuing to use after the expiration of a

license, any title or abbreviation prescribed by the board for use only by persons currently holding that type of class of license.

However, Licensee and the Board mutually desire to enter a Consent Agreement and Order in lieu of adjudicative proceedings to resolve the reported violations.

WHEREFORE, Licensee waives all rights to an adjudication of facts and law which could be determined pursuant to a hearing conducted in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act in relation to Case No. 12-BS-0083.

WHEREFORE, Licensee waives the right to file a motion for reconsideration and all rights of appeal pursuant to the Kansas Judicial Review Act in relation to Case No. 12-BS-0083.

WHEREFORE, Licensee consents to the following terms and conditions:

- (a) Licensee is hereby formally censured.
- (b) Licensee shall notify Washburn University internship program in writing of the violation.
A copy of such written notification shall also be sent to the Board.
- (c) Licensee shall complete three extra hours of continuing education in honesty/ethics in practice and professional responsibility to agency clients. The three additional hours of continuing education shall be conducted by Licensee in person within 180 days of the effective date of this Consent Agreement and Order. This condition shall be deemed satisfied upon the Board's receipt of Licensee's written proof of completion of the three extra hours of continuing education by or before 180 days of the effective date of this Consent Agreement and Order. Failure to provide the Board with written proof of completion of the extra continuing education hours by or before 180 days of the effective date is a violation of this Consent Agreement and Order and may result in further action by the Board.
- (d) Licensee shall research, write, and submit to the Board a 5-10-page professional paper on

the following subjects: (1) honesty/ethics in practice, and (2) professional responsibility to agency clients. The paper shall contain 5-10 professional literature references. The paper shall be double-spaced with one-inch margins and in American Psychological Association (APA) format. The paper shall be submitted to the Board by or before 90 days from the effective date of this Consent Agreement and Order. Failure to submit the professional paper to the Board by or before 90 days of the effective date is a violation of this Consent Agreement and Order and may result in further action by the Board. This condition shall be deemed satisfied upon the reviewing Board member's approval of the professional paper.

- (e) Licensee shall be responsible for any costs and expenses incurred in satisfying the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order.
- (f) Licensee understands that a notification of this Consent Agreement and Order shall be provided to any other state licensing board if Licensee is also licensed, registered or certified in another state.
- (g) Licensee acknowledges an affirmative duty to notify the Board within five (5) days of any changes in personal or professional status which would inhibit compliance with any condition of this Consent Agreement and Order. In such event, a designee of the Board is authorized to modify or amend this Consent Agreement and Order in writing.
- (h) This Consent Agreement and Order constitutes the entire agreement between the Licensee and the Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board and may be modified or amended only by written agreement signed by Licensee and the Board or a designee of the Board.


WHEREFORE, Licensee consents to the submission of this Consent Agreement and Order to the Board's Complaint Review Committee and understands that, upon approval by the

Complaint Review Committee, this Consent Agreement and Order will become a Final Order of the Board. The Board has authorized the Complaint Review Committee to determine the validity of this Consent Agreement and Order.

WHEREFORE, the Board agrees that, so long as Licensee complies with the conditions, the Board will not initiate further disciplinary action against Licensee in relation to violations of K.S.A. 65-6311 and K.A.R. 102-2-7 as a result of this proceeding.


WHEREFORE, the foregoing provisions are consented to, are hereby made the final Order of the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board, and become effective on the date indicated in the Certificate of Service below.
