This office represents the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board ("BSRB"). The Complaint Review Committee met to review the above complaint against you. The Committee found probable cause of violations of K.S.A. 65-6311(a)(4) and K.A.R. 102-2-7(w) and (jj). Specifically, you engaged in billing practices involving misrepresentation and took credit for work not personally performed by giving inaccurate or misleading information or by failing to disclose accurate or material information.

The Board has determined the appropriate sanction on this complaint to be a Formal Censure pursuant to K.S.A. 74-7508(f). You should consider this letter to be the Formal Censure. This sanction will not affect your ability to practice master level social work in Kansas.
