SUMMARY PROCEEDING ORDER OF REVOCATION

NOW, on this <u>J4</u> day of January, 2014, the above-captioned complaint comes before the Complaint Review Committee [Committee] of the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board [Board].

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

The Committee finds that the following facts have been established by a preponderance of clear and convincing evidence:

- 1. Vanessa Palenske, a/k/a Vanessa Dudley-Miller, was a Licensed Masters Social Worker, License #6346, which was issued by the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board.
- 2. At all times relevant to the complaint herein, Licensee was practicing as a Licensed Masters Social Worker within the meaning of the Kansas Social Workers Licensure Act, K.S.A. 65-6301, et seq., and amendments thereto.
- 3. On or about November 7, 2012, the Board received information that Licensee was marrying a client to whom she had provided social worker services as recently as the summer of 2012.

4. Licensee was informed about the complaint and was requested to respond in writing but failed to respond to the allegations. Rather, she requested voluntary surrender of her Kansas Licensed Masters Social Worker license.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The following conclusions of law are based on evidence the Committee finds is clear and convincing:

- 1. The Kansas Administrative Procedure Act [K.A.P.A.], K.S.A. 77-537, provides that a state agency may use summary proceedings, subject to a party's request for a hearing on the order, if the use of the proceedings in the circumstances does not violate any provision of law and the protection of the public interest does not require the state agency to give notice and an opportunity to participate to persons other than the parties.
- 2. The actions of Vanessa Palenske, a/k/a Vanessa Dudley-Miller, violate: K.S.A. 65-6311. Grounds for suspension, limitation, revocation or refusal to issue or renew license; procedure.
- (a) The board may suspend, limit, revoke, condition or refuse to issue or renew a license of any social worker upon proof that the social worker:
 - (4) has been found guilty of unprofessional conduct as defined by rules established by the board;

K.A.R. 102-2-7, Unprofessional Conduct,

- (y) making sexual advances toward or engaging in physical intimacies or sexual activities with one's client, supervisee, or student;
- (z) making sexual advances toward, engaging in physical intimacies or sexual activities

with, or exercising undue influence over any person who, within the past 24 months, has been one's client; and

(tt) engaging in a dual relationship with a client, supervisee, or student.

3. K.S.A. 74-7508 authorizes the Board to revoke a license that has been

voluntarily surrendered:

(e) In all matters pending before the behavioral sciences regulatory board, the board

shall have the power to revoke the license or registration of any licensee or registrant

who voluntarily surrenders such person's license or registration pending investigation of

misconduct or while charges of misconduct against the licensee are pending ...

III. SANCTION

Based on the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and pursuant to K.S.A. 74-7508, K.S.A. 65-6311(a) and K.S.A. 77-537, the Committee orders as

follows:

A. The surrender of the Licensed Masters Social Worker license of Vanessa

Palenske, a/k/a Vanessa Dudley-Miller, is accepted. Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-7508,

this license is hereby revoked.

B. This Order shall be posted to the Board's website and provided to HIPDB

and any other jurisdictions where Licensee is known to have been licensed.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
