SUMMARY PROCEEDING ORDER OF STATUTORY REVOCATION

NOW, on this 17th day of JANUARY, 2018, the above-captioned matters come before the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board [BSRB, Board] Complaint Review Committee [Committee], by and through Assistant Attorney General Marty M. Snyder.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board finds that the following facts have been established by a preponderance of persuasive evidence:

1. David R. Mouille [Licensee / Respondent] was at all times relevant a Licensed Psychologist [LP] within the meaning of the Kansas Licensure of Psychologists Act, K.S.A. 74-5301, *et seq.*, and amendments thereto.
2. On October 31, 2017, the Board received a written notice from Respondent that he intended to surrender his Kansas Licensed Psychologist license effective immediately. Accordingly, Respondent's licensure status was changed on the Board's database to "LP 794 Surrendered." [Exhibit A]

3. Board staff reported this information to the BSRB Complaint Review Committee as Respondent had two formal disciplinary complaints pending that had not yet gone to hearing. [Exhibit B]

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. The Complaint Review Committee of the Board finds that the following statutes apply to the above facts:

A. K.S.A. 74-7508


(e) In all matters pending before the behavioral sciences regulatory board, the board shall have the power to revoke the license or registration of any licensee or registrant who voluntarily surrenders such person's license or registration pending investigation of misconduct or while charges of misconduct against the licensee are pending or anticipated.

B. K.S.A. 77-537(a) (1-4).

5. The Board concludes that Respondent surrendered his LP license while charges of misconduct against him were pending or anticipated and that this matter is appropriate for summary disposition pursuant to the terms of K.S.A. 77-537.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-537 [KAPA] and the Kansas Licensure of Psychologists Act, K.S.A. 74-7508, the Board finds that David R. Mouille's Kansas Licensed Psychologist license should be and is hereby revoked, effective pursuant to the Notice of Relief and Certificate of Service below.

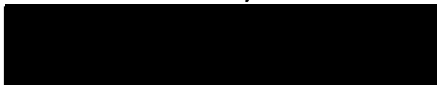


