Dear Mr. Rodriguez-Negron:


As you know, the Complaint Review Committee of the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board found probable cause to believe you violated K.S.A. 65-6311 and K.A.R.s 102-2-7(s) and (t) in your failure to obtain written informed consent from clients prior to revealing confidences and other information contained in the client's records to an unauthorized person. It is the Committee's understanding that this was an unusual incident and may have been influenced by different understandings of the language used.

After discussing formal and informal resolution of this complaint with your attorney and with the Committee and in light of recent statutory changes, the Board has determined to issue a reprimand in lieu of scheduling this matter for a formal disciplinary hearing.

This constitutes a Final Agency Action. If you wish to appeal it, you must file a Notice of Appeal within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this letter. The Notice must be served upon Phyllis Gilmore, Executive Director, BSRB, 712 South Kansas Avenue, Topeka, KS 66603 pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act and the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions.


Dear Vernon:
