This office represents the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board. The Complaint Review Committee met last week and reviewed your self-report of practicing on an expired license for seven months. The Board has found probable cause of violations of KSA 65-5803 and 65-5806.

In light of the self-report and no history of other violations, the Committee has determined the appropriate sanction to be a formal reprimand. It was noted that as a new licensee, you have never renewed this license previously. Please keep in mind that it will expire every March 31 of odd-numbered years, and it is your responsibility to assure that the Board has your correct current address.
