Findings of Fact

The Committee finds that the following findings of facts have been established by clear and convincing evidence:

- 1. Susan L. Adkins (Licensee / Respondent) is a Licensed Specialist Clinical Social Worker, license #1601, issued by the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board (Board / Petitioner).
- 2. At all times relevant, Licensee has been practicing as Licensed Specialist Clinical Social Worker within the meaning of the Kansas Social Workers Act, K.S.A. 65-6301 et

seq. and amendments thereto.

3. Licensee first received her LSCSW license in February of 1994. The most recent expiration date was February of 2004.

4. Licensee failed to renew her license in February of 2004, and the license expired.

5. Licensee continued to practice as a LSCSW at Grace Connections Mental Health Services after her license had expired.

6. Licensee subsequently contacted the Board in September of 2004 and had her license reinstated in September of 2004.

Conclusions of Law

7. The Committee finds by clear and convincing evidence that the above facts constitute violations of the Kansas Social Workers Act, KSA 65-6301 *et seq.*, as defined as follows.

8. The practice of social work without a current license is a violation of KSA 65-6311 and constitutes unprofessional conduct.

Sanction

Based on the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Committee, on behalf of the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board, finds that Susan L. Adkins should receive a formal reprimand for failing to renew her license in a timely manner and for continuing to practice social work with an expired license.
